**Coaching Code of Ethics for
Pavilion Skating Club of Cleveland Heights
July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019**

As a coach on PSC sessions, I take full responsibility for the following and agree that I will abide by the Constitution, By-Laws, all Rules and Regulations of the Pavilion Skating Club of Cleveland Heights (PSC) including this PSC Coaching Code of Ethics.

1. I am a member of PSA and abide by its CODE OF ETHICS.
2. I have completed the coach's registration process, passed the background check, and purchased liability insurance. Without proof of insurance, I understand I will not be allowed to coach, nullifying any agreements/contracts with PSC.
3. I have completed the CER requirement for basic education. I will provide proof of CER A or B.
4. I will maintain my SAFESPORT Training and abide by the SAFESPORT policies including the reporting of incidents.
5. I will encourage my students to pay all fees owed to PSC and to pay all ice fees to the monitor prior to entering the ice.
6. I will teach only my students and under no circumstances will I teach or give instruction to another student without their coach's full knowledge.
7. I will not discourage or hinder a skater from participating in any figure skating discipline.
8. I will encourage harmony, goodwill and ethical behavior among the skaters, parents, pros and rink personnel.
9. As a staff pro, I will participate and support PSC activities. Any complaints regarding PSC, or its activities, will be brought to the PSC Board.
10. I will dress and behave in a professional manner at all times.
11. I understand that the club rules are posted at the rink. I will support the club rules being enforced on the ice.
12. I understand that I have the right and the obligation to bring any concerns I have to the PSC Board for discussion. Concerns that need to be addressed immediately should be presented to an officer of PSC. I will present my concerns in a respectful manner and out of earshot of those who are not involved.
13. I will not participate in gossip or speculation regarding skaters, professionals or PSC activities. In refraining from this behavior, I understand that I am setting a good example for the skaters.
14. I understand that disruptive behavior on the ice and off the ice will not be tolerated. This includes yelling, use of profanity or any behavior that demeans another person. I will be asked to leave the ice for the remainder of the day if I exhibit disruptive behavior. Repeated infractions will result in loss of teaching privileges at PSC.
15. I shall not engage in verbal or physical misconduct towards any skater, professionals, parents, board members, monitors, officials or rink management.
