



Jump Harness Policy and Coach Acknowledgement

1. Prior to use of the figure skating jump harness at Pavilion Skating Club / Cleveland Heights Recreation Center, figure skating coaches must be currently approved to coach on Club and City Freestyle sessions. This requires the proper liability insurance and PSA membership that the Pro Staff Committee requires.
2. Only approved coaches will be granted permission to use the figure skating jump harness after the coach has acknowledged that he/she has read this document, and has watched the training video OR has been trained by a Club Officer.
3. It is the coach's responsibility to report the name of any skater that they will be training in the harness to the member of arena staff acting as session monitor. The skater must have current, signed figure skating jump harness consent for use form on file with Pavilion Skating Club. These rules still apply to coaches who wish to use the harness during City Freestyle sessions because the harness is property of Pavilion Skating Club. If under 18 years of age, a parent/legal guardian must sign the form.
4. It is the coach's responsibility to properly attach the belt to the pull rope and to their skater at the start of their training session.
5. It is the coach's responsibility to properly detach the belt from their skater and the pull rope at the end of their training session.
6. It is the coach's responsibility to properly secure the harness and pull rope, and to hoist and secure the nylon rope in the lock box after each harness session.
